Cadmus Slays the Serpent Agenor, king of Tyre, had a beautiful daughter, Europa, whom Zeus loved. This Phoenician princess was the mother of Minos, the mythological king of Crete, and of Rhadamanthys, who some say was the judge of the dead in Hades, while others place him in the Islands of the Blessed or the Elysian Fields.

Ovid's depiction of this colossal monster may have inspired Milton's description of the serpent in Eden (Paradise Lost 9.500f) Cadmus's father Agenor was the brother of Belus, whose family produced many famous heroes as well: Danaus (see notes on book 1 and 4), Perseus (book 4 below), and Heracles (book 9).
